Pastor Patrick and The All Nations Gospel Outreach Team is taking God's saving, healing, and deliverance power to all nations throughout the world, rekindling revival fire and equipping the body of Christ in power and fire evangelism and healing ministry. All Nations Gospel Outreach Ministries conducts many healing crusades throughout Africa, India, South America, Europe, and beyond. Thousands have been saved, healed and delivered.

Pastor Patrick and All Nations Gospel Outreach Ministries have felt that it is time to multiply the tangible healing anointing, train and disciple the church to pray for the sick, and take trips into the nations to spread the fires of the healing revival. These trips will help to facilitate his vision on the coming revival of power through miracles, signs and wonders.

Specifically, Pastor Patrick believes that in order to have maximum impact, his ministry needs to take pastors and disciples to the nations. So, All Nations Gospel Outreach Ministries wants to take teams to the nations and to provide opportunity, on short-term mission's trips, for those on the teams to **be used mightily by God and to receive impartation and training**. Either Pastor Patrick, one of the anointed All Nations Gospel Outreach Ministries team or an All Nations associate minister will lead each mission's trip, taking the corporate anointing of the ministry to the nations with signs following!

Do you long to see the works of the Lord, and greater works than these, in our modern times? If so, join us for one of our ministry/missions trips. Become a participant with All Nations' Mission Team on a life-changing ministry/missions trip. Have you ever longed to see the paralytics walk, the deaf hear, the blind see, the lepers cleansed, and the demonic set free? Have you wanted to feed the hungry, preach, and do the ministry of Jesus? If your answer is "yes," then one of these mission trips could be the trip for you! But please respond quickly because we have limited availability on All Nations' mission trips.

WHAT WILL YOU DO ON A MISSIONS TRIP WITH US?

The ministry teams will meet nightly on any All Nations Missions Trip, and will pray for hundreds if not thousands of people to be saved, healed, and delivered. In addition there will be several impartation and anointing times with All Nations staff.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

As you can see, we ask for a fairly in-depth amount of information, some of which is quite personal and yet understandably so considering the scope of such a ministry trip. Often, the first time we meet a team member is when we gather at the airport, on route to the ministry/mission location. Therefore, it is absolutely imperative that we have personal knowledge and background information before approval is granted for team participation. Please be assured that all information provided is kept strictly confidential between the All Nations Missions Coordinators and Team Leaders.

TEAMS

Each person on the trip will be placed on a team with other team members, a team leader and team intercession coordinator. Teams may be formed from one specific church or ministry, or may consist of individuals from different churches, denominations, or regions of the country.

MINISTRY CONDITIONS

Some of the places and hotel conditions we will visit may seem primitive in comparison to what you are used to. The pace required on these trips can be rigorous, emotionally draining, and at times, physically exhausting. Every team member must be able to stand through long days and continue functioning autonomously and pace themselves under what can sometimes be trying conditions. We ask that you be prepared to run and not grow weary, to walk and not faint! On the other hand, the rewards of being a part of God pouring out His Spirit on His people are immeasurable!

The key word is flexibility. Plans can change last minute. Exhaustion can set in. So it's important to come with an attitude of servant hood. Our objective is to serve and be Christ to everyone we come into contact with from our fellow team members, to the people we are praying for, to the bus driver driving us around.

COST

The cost of a trip is dependent upon many factors and can vary from trip to trip. A typical overseas trip can cost from approx. \$3000-\$5500 USD. Costs include: Airfare from US Hub, Two meals a day, Hotel Accommodations, Ground transportation, All Nations Ministries T-shirt, Travel Medical Insurance, Airport Taxes, Day Trip & Administration Fees.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please send all completed forms to the All Nations Missions address. Receipt of your deposit tentatively holds your spot pending review and approval of your application package. Space is limited and acceptance is based on a first come, first serve basis. If a deposit is not received with your application, we regret that we cannot process your application. Make checks & money orders payable to "All Nations". All amounts must be in U.S. dollars.

You will receive a confirmation e-mail when your application has been received to confirm whether or not we have a completed application package. An acceptance email will be provided upon approval of your application and qualifications. At the close of the registration an informational e-mail containing all details of the trip will be emailed.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

Matthew 18:15-17, And if your brother sins, go and reprove him in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother. "But if he does not listen to you, take one or two more with you, so that BY THE MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES EVERY FACT MAY BE CONFIRMED. And if he refuses to listen to them, tell it to the church; and if he refuses to listen even to the church, let him be to you as a Gentile and a tax-gatherer.

It is our intent to follow biblical patterns of discipline within the confines of our ministry trips.

All Nations Missions guidelines will outline the procedures that will be followed so as to avoid as many misunderstandings as possible. You are asked to read the outlined procedures below, sign the consent form, and return it to us. In doing this you agree to receive correction, public rebuke and/or removal and finally corporate compliance with the decisions made by leadership as outlined in the procedures. If issues of sin or disobedience come to light, rest assured, we will follow the steps below to bring resolution to the situation.

The reasoning is simple. These trips are attempting to open up countries to renewal and revival and therefore attract spiritual warfare. We realize that if you are not right with God, the accuser will find an opening and use it against you. If the door is not open too wide then a slight correction will bring resolve to the situation. If sin has had its hold for too long, even correction by loving brothers and sisters may not turn you aside. If that should happen, you will be asked to leave and if you choose not to leave, we will bring you before the ministry team and inform them that they must have nothing to do with you. In signing this consent form, you agree to abide by the decisions of All Nations Missions leadership and their collective wisdom in handling such matters.

We realize that it is difficult if not inappropriate for everyone to know the particulars of any given situation and that you must trust those in authority over you to seek the Lord in their decisions. In signing this you agree to abide by their decisions totally. You must understand that we want nothing more than to work side by side with each of you. However, we must be realistic as the apostles were, and follow the guidelines they have laid before us. Believe me when I tell you that we have had ministry trips almost destroyed because of one person's disobedience or sin. It is because of these experiences that we have endeavored to bring order where the enemy would want confusion and destruction. We are at war and therefore compliance with the decisions is not optional but mandatory.

1. We believe that if you have a problem with anyone you are to go to that person, without going to anyone else first. Go and attempt to bring understanding and resolution. If it is with someone of the opposite sex, then talk with him or her in a place where others are around but cannot hear. Many times what you consider a problem is only a misunderstanding and bringing it to their attention often brings resolution.

2. If you find no resolution after you have talked with them, you are to bring it to your Team Leader. The individuals involved are required to go and discuss the problem with the Team Leader. Then the Team Leader will determine what the problem is, who is at fault, and bring closure to the situation.

3. If your Team Leader finds later that there has been no closure after his meeting, he will confront the parties with the Event Coordinator. He will be informed of the situation by the Team Leader and will bring another voice of reason and authority to bring closure to a difficult situation.

4. If the Team Leader and Event Coordinator have found the person to be in *rebellion to correction* then they will inform the senior All Nations representative and he will bring final closure to the situation in which all parties will be present to hear how the matter shall be ended. At this time options will be given as to how it will end and end it will. The possible options may include returning home within 24 hours or be brought before the All Nations Missions/Ministry Team. If the second option is chosen, the ministry team will be informed to not have anything to do with you throughout the remainder of the trip. You will not be allowed to ride, eat, sleep, or be with any member of the team. The team will not have anything to do with you.

5. If what you are involved in is a sin that cannot at the discretion of leadership be taken care of in a timely manner or would affect the team in an adverse way, leadership reserves the right to go immediately to step 4.

6. In signing this agreement you not only agree to follow these procedures for discipline if you are directly involved, but you also agree as a team member to follow the directions of leadership regarding other team members.
